Grants for artists and orgs that provide arts programming

Currently also have emergency artist relief fund through SOS (specific opportunity stipend)

Several other grants for arts programming (virtual events, equipment, etc.)

Community Foundation

Broad range of giving priorities.

Health Foundation of WCNY

Funding priorities are older adult and children under 5 years old and resiliency in communities.

Rolling out additional information this fall.

Legacy Foundation

Focused on COVID 19 primary needs (food, shelter, medical needs).

Fall cycle postponed from Sep 15 to Oct 15.

Park Foundation

Funding priorities are primarily youth and human services around social justice.

Regular cycle of funding and specific funding for COVID 19 needs.

Triad Foundation

Priorities in Ithaca are around pathways to opportunity – job training, equitable basic needs, higher education, child welfare, general operating support.

Rolling 3 week grant cycle. Send 1-2 page letter to the foundation.
